Commercial print run over 1,000 £50.00

TELEVISION/FILM/VIDEO £50.00

COMMERCIAL EXHIBITION £50.00

The above charges apply on a per format and territory basis - charges covering extended territories are subject to negotiation on an individual basis

Costs for Prints, colour transparencies and digital files from images are invoiced to the customer (please refer to Print Price List) in addition to a search/scan fee, charged per hour or part thereof at the following rates:

Members £10.00

Non-members £20.00

A minimum fee of £20 for non-members and £10 for members is charged on all reproduction requests
